Between 2018 and 2022 the broader textile retail industry accounted for about 1.3 % of the national workforce. Also, in 2023 the fashion sector's contribution to Spain's GDP increased to 2.7% reflecting its growing economic significance.

 Positioned at the heart of Europe, Spain offers strategic access to EU markets and trade routes to North Africa, Latin America, and Asia.


